**Title:** Entering a Pause Command In Message Notification Requires T Command  
- Aspire Mail/UltraMail

---

When entering a Message Notification callout number, any pause commands in the dial string must be immediately followed by a T command. This is required to enable Aspire Mail/UltraMail to continue DTMF dialing. Without the T command, any digits following the pause will not be dialed.

Note: When entering a Message Notification callout number from a telephone, the T command is entered by dialing \*T (\*8).
